# Monitoring of KPC meetings for the period January - June 2023

During the first six months of 2023 (January-June), the Kosovo Prosecutorial Council held a total of 6 meetings.

These meetings were monitored through the ZOOM platform.<sup>1</sup>



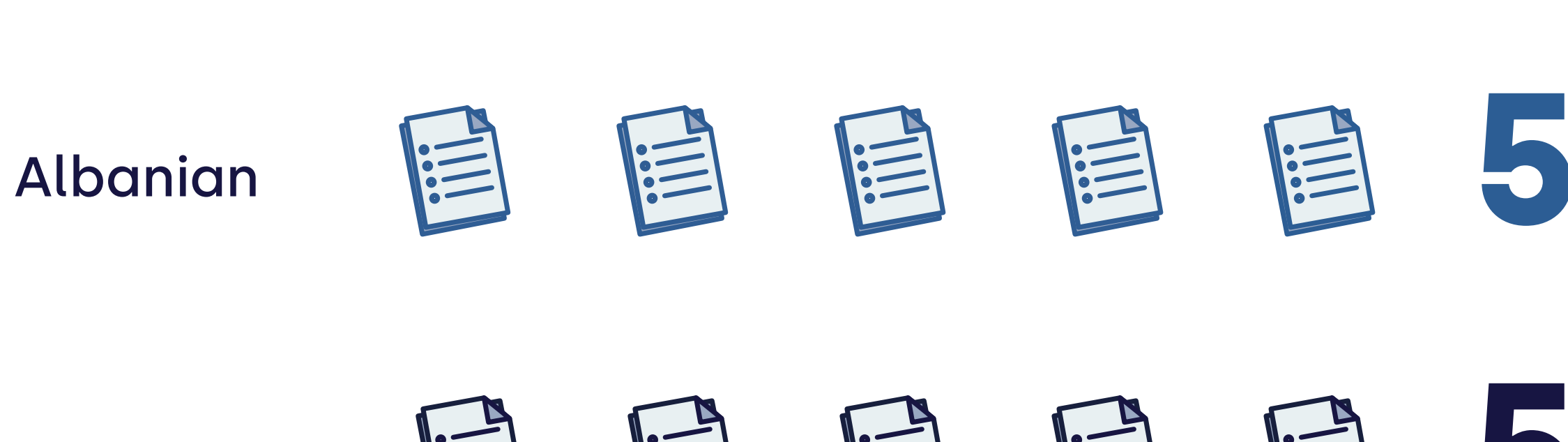

For five meetings held, the agendas were published on time, as provided for in the Law on the Kosovo Prosecutorial Council, namely in its article 14<sup>2</sup>. However, for the meeting held in April, the agenda has not been published at all.<sup>3</sup>

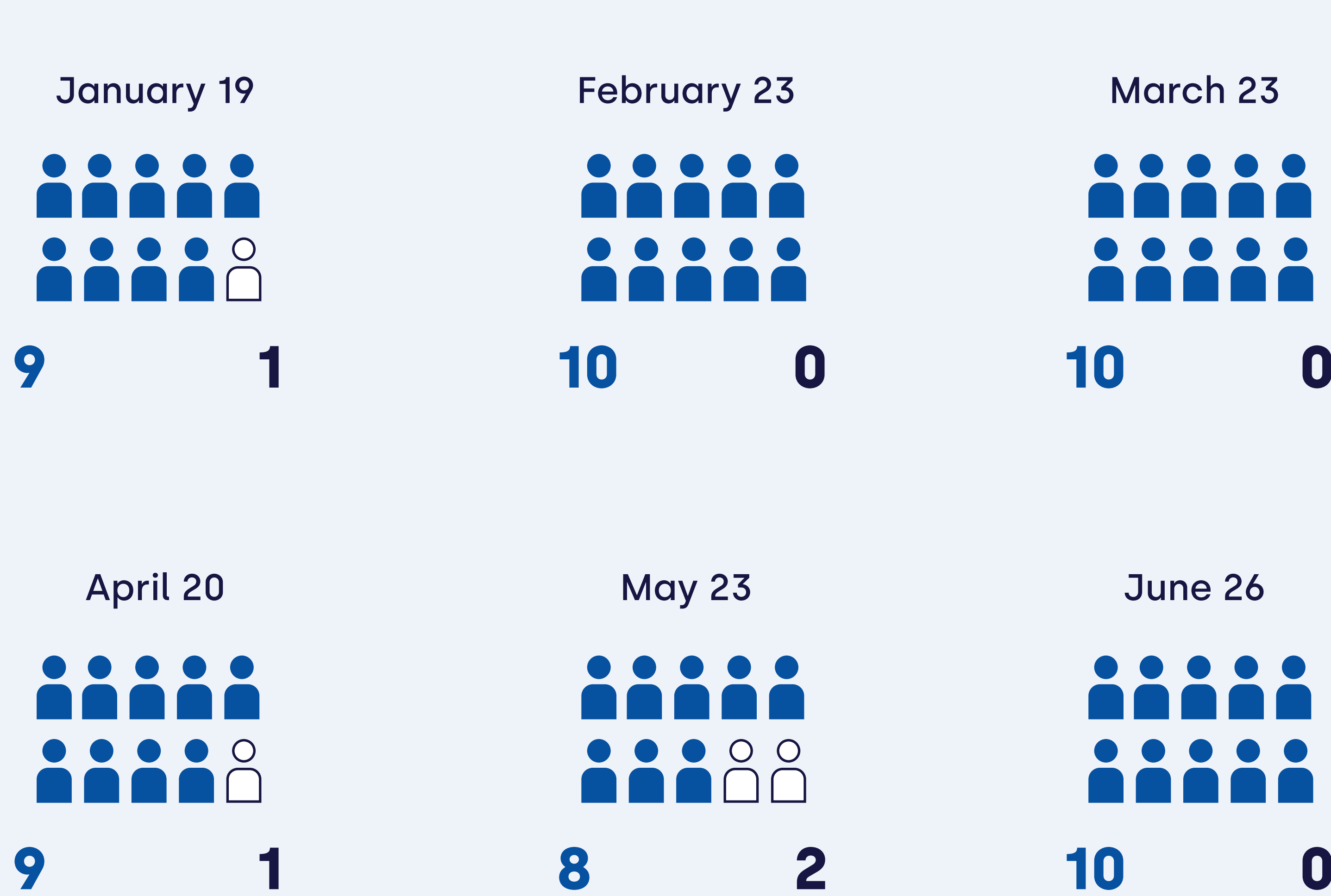

Present      Absent

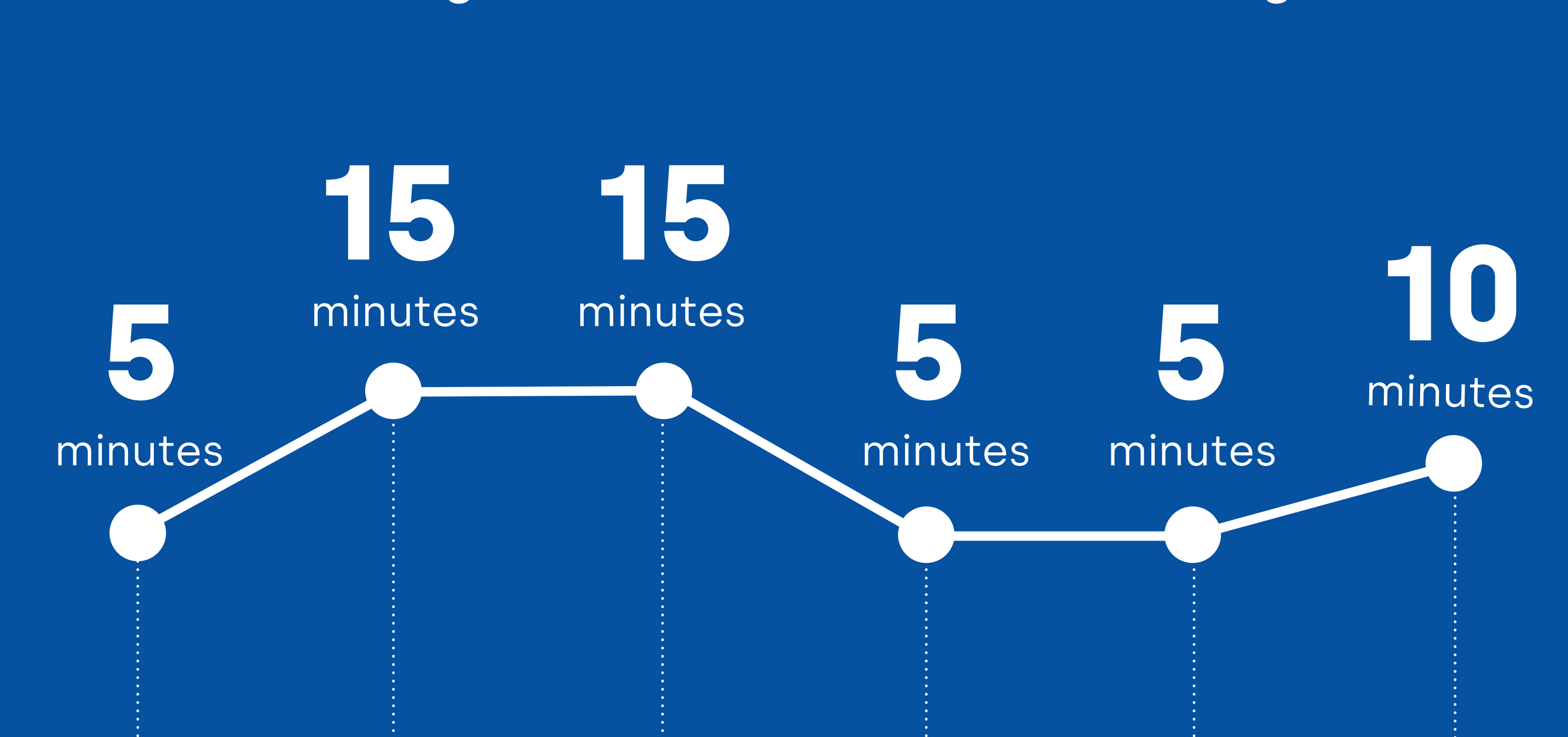


During this monitoring period, 7 items of agenda of the held meetings were closed to the public. It is worth noting that two items of agenda were closed at the last moment after the KPC meeting began.



**29** The Kosovo Prosecutorial Council has published 29 decisions on its official website from the meetings they held.
